We hope that you and your family are doing well. Enclosed is your annual organizer for your 2022 taxes. It's been an interesting year with important tax changes that will impact you. Here are some of the changes and issues you need to know about.

#### Changes and issues for 2022:

- \* Individuals must file returns by April 18, 2023, for the 2022 tax year.
- \* The standard deduction has risen to 12,950 Single and \$25,900 Married!
- \* Capital gains rates are still at 0%, 15% and 20% depending on your taxable income.
- \* Teacher supply deduction is now \$300
- \* IRA contributions are now \$6,500, with \$1,000 catch-up.
- \* Mileage is 58.5 cents, rising to 62.5 cents for the second half of the year.
- \* Gift limit amounts has risen to \$17,000 for 2023.
- \* Some energy credits are back, for windows, doors, roofs, etc.

#### How to get your information to us!

- \* You do not necessarily need an appointment, if you are a returning client and not much has changed, just leave notes!
- \* There are a number of other ways to get your tax information to us:
- 1. Mail your tax information to Mary Cheek CPA, PO Box 1966, Chester CA, 96020.
- 2. Drop you paperwork off at our office, Monday to Thrusday, 10-4.
- 3. After hours, just drop your tax information in the secure mail slot in our front door. Remember to put your name, address, and phone number on the front of the packet (use any type of secure packaging gallon zip lock bags work great!).
- 4. Email the information to us at MaryCheekCPA@FrontierNet.Net (all documents as <u>one scanned .pdf file</u>). Or fax to 1-877-881-1103.

Please see the attached year-end checklist as a reminder of what to collect for your tax return preparation. Collect all supporting tax documents, including 1099s, W2s, and other statements, and return everything to our office. Because of the complexities of the new tax laws, we are requesting that you have your tax information into us no later than Friday, March 24, 2023. If you bring your info after March 24th, and wish to have it done by April 15th, there will be a "rush/late filing" fee of \$75.

Call us to request an extension if one is needed as we cannot automatically file an extension for you. If an extension of time to file is requested, we will use the information available to us at the time to prepare the extension. There will be a \$75 extension filing fee, which must be paid at the time of the extension. REMEMBER: an extension only provides you with an extension to file, not an extension to pay. Taxes paid after April 15 will result in late-payment penalties and interest.

I appreciate your trust in giving us the opportunity to prepare your 2022 taxes.
